

### College Coaches Contact Preparation Checklist

Before contacting college coaches to seek exposure and be evaluated, you want to make sure you are prepared. Being prepared means you:

- 1) Have the physical and academic skillset that the coach is looking for
- 2) Have the necessary documents and information that coaches will need to evaluate you prepared and ready to share

Here is a list of what you need to have ready for when you start contacting and hearing from college coaches:

- Recruiting Email Address
- Email template you can alter for each school of interest (no mass emails or form emails, must personalize)
- Skills video (with link to include in emails)
- Current/Future game schedule
- Updated hard copies of SAT/ACT score
- Updated electronic copies of SAT/ACT score
- Updated hard copies of academic transcript
- Updated electronic copies of academic transcript
- Documentation of learning disabilities (if applicable)
- Contact information of your coaches and other baseball references you plan to have vouch for your abilities
- Copies of your parents' tax returns for seniors who will file a FAFSA ( FAFSA applications are available starting in October)
